This sailing season, three 'two week learn to sail sessions for juniors' will be offered throughout July and August. Sailors will have plenty of opportunity to work toward their White Sail and Bronze Sail CYA certifications.

Dinghy racing nights will be held on Wednesday evenings throughout the summer. There will be a barbeque and junior dinghy racing (prams and 420s) on those nights that fall inside of the sailing sessions.

In addition, there will be an Adult Learn to Sail Program which will run once a week, for two separate, three week sessions. This program will use prams, 420s and keelboats for learning basic sailing and more advanced crewing.

THE CAPE BRETON ISLAND CLIPPER



The Cape Breton Island Clipper is 68 foot yacht that is adorned by a magnificent bald eagle. This yacht is the only Canadian entry in the prestigious Clipper 09-10 Round the World Yacht Race.

The Clipper 09-10 Round the World Yacht Race, originally established by Sir Robin Knox-Johnston in 1995, when he set up Clipper Ventures, is taking place from September 2009 until July 2010. Since 1995, the Clipper organization has successfully organized six round the world yacht races.

The seventh race began on September 13th, 2009, when a fleet of ten identical 68-foot stripped down yachts departed the Humber (Hull, UK) on the northeast coast of England and embarked on an around the globe race. The yachts will travel 35,000 miles and stop in fourteen ports of call on five continents within ten months.

On June 6th, 2010, the clippers will leave New York City and race toward Sydney Harbour, Cape Breton Island. The Clipper Race Yachts are expected to arrive in Sydney throughout the day and night at the Joan Harris Cruise Pavilion between Friday, June 11th and Sunday, June 13th.
